

Surry County, Virginia Personal Property Taxes 1782-1827

The personal property tax books for Surry County, Virginia run almost continually from 1782 until 1850. The records here abstract the entries for several connected families living along the Blackwater Swamp in what is now southern Surry County. Each year's taxpayers are listed alphabetically, so I have not listed the page numbers on which their names appear in each year's tax book. In most cases, the pages were not numbered, anyway.

The abstracts below give information from the personal property tax records for relatives of the wives of John Stiles Sr., a shoemaker from New York who appears to have arrived in Virginia immediately after the Revolutionary War. In December 1782, he married Mary Sebrell, and in 1788, he married Jane Cooper. These marriages form connections between these three Surry County, Virginia families:

Stiles – John Stiles Sr. first appears on Surry County personal property tax lists in 1784 and is found on every list through 1810. His sons, John Stiles Jr. and Leroy Stiles, begin appearing in the early 1800s as they passed the age of sixteen.

Sebrell – Nathaniel Sebrell Sr. appears on every tax list from 1782 until his death in 1815. The father-in-law of John Stiles Sr., Nathaniel married in the mid-1750s to Elizabeth Faulcon, daughter of Nicholas Faulcon Sr. Nathaniel's sons, Nathaniel Jr., David, John, James, and Nicholas Sebrell, all appear on the tax lists in various years. Only David Sebrell outlived his father.

Cooper – Jane Cooper, the second wife of John Stiles Sr., was the daughter of George Cooper and Mary Ellis, who appear to have married about 1750. George had died in late 1781 or early 1782 and never appears on a Surry County tax list. In 1782, his widow and children all paid taxes on property that George bequeathed to them in his will.

Identifications

Carsley

Elizabeth Sebrell & Michael Carsley III – About 1783 or 1784, Elizabeth Sebrell, daughter of Nathaniel Sebrell Sr., married Michael Carsley III. Michael's father, Michael Carsley Jr., died in 1780, leaving many sons. In the early years, officials recorded the surname in the tax records as "*Casley*," but later records give it as "*Carsley*" or "*Carseley*." Michael Carsley III died in late 1799 or January 1800, and Elizabeth Sebrell Carsley pays the taxes on their property until 1810. It appears that she died late that year or early in 1811.

William Carsley (c1785–1821) – He married in 1811 to Mary Ellis (Polly), and they settled on his parents' old farm near Blackwater Swamp. After his death, Polly paid taxes on one slave until her death about 1826.

Nicholas Carsley (c1800–1834) – He appears to have lived with his older brother until the latter 1810s. He married in 1820 to Sarah Justiss, but like his brother and so many relatives, he died young.

Cooper

Frederick Cooper – The only son of George Cooper, he farmed his father's land until his death in 1805. In 1791, he married Elizabeth (Betsy) Dewell, daughter of Thomas Dewell and Elizabeth Barnes. They had one daughter, Rebecca, who married in 1812 to John Stiles Jr. Frederick's first two wives died young, and in 1799, he married in Sussex County to a widow, Elizabeth Barker. In his will, Frederick left his 100-acre farm to his only child, Rebecca, after Elizabeth's death. She paid the land taxes on his lands until her death in 1823.

John Cooper – The brother of George Cooper, making him the uncle of Jane Cooper Stiles. He served as the local constable in the 1780s and 1790s, possibly excluding him from paying a white poll tax. He died in 1795. His daughter, Permelia Cooper, married in 1800 to John Velvin, and he served in many local governmental capacities.

Collier

Emelia Cooper & John Collier Jr. – Emelia Cooper was the daughter of George and Mary Ellis Cooper, and she married about 1770 to John Collier Jr., son of John Collier Sr. and Lucy Mooring. Lucy Collier paid taxes on her personal property until her death in 1791, outliving her son, who died about 1790. Afterwards, Emelia Collier paid taxes on her farm until her death in 1815.

Benjamin, John, & George Cooper Collier – These three sons of Emelia Cooper Collier and John Collier Jr. who all remained in Surry County. George Cooper Collier died in 1826, and John died

in the 1840s. It appears that Benjamin Collier moved to Prince George County in the 1830s and lived there in 1840, but his widow lived in Surry in 1850.

Dewell

Thomas Dewell – He married about 1760 to Elizabeth Barnes, daughter of Henry and Naomi Barnes. Between about 1760 and his death in 1795, he lived on a 325-acre farm on the Blackwater Swamp near Nathaniel Sebrell and Frederick Cooper. His daughter, Elizabeth (Betsy) (c1765–1797), married Frederick Cooper in 1791.

Henry Dewell – Born about 1760, he inherited most of the lands of his father, Thomas, on the Blackwater Swamp near Nathaniel Sebrell and Frederick Cooper. Henry Dewell died in 1830.

Faulcon

Nicholas Faulcon Sr. – The son of Isaac Faulcon who arrived in Surry County by 1700, Nicholas worked as a tobacco farmer during his long life. He wrote his will in 1781 and died in 1783. Nicholas is found only on the 1782 and 1783 personal property tax list, for by 1784, his executors had distributed his property.

Nicholas Faulcon Jr. & Jacob Faulcon – Sons of Nicholas Faulcon Sr. and brothers-in-law of Nathaniel Sebrell, both men served as officers in the Surry County Militia during the Revolutionary War and held influential positions in Surry County. Jacob served as the clerk of court for the latter two decades of the eighteenth century, and Nicholas served in the House of Burgesses and Virginia's Constitutional Convention. Both were also large plantation owners. Jacob Faulcon married Ann Spratley, the only known daughter of John and Mary Spratley (see below).

Nicholas Faulcon III – The son of Nicholas Faulcon Jr., he was born about 1765. Like his father, he served in Virginia's General Assembly, in both the House of Delegates and State Senate. He owned the Mount Pleasant Plantation on the James River that British troops ransacked in 1813 during the War of 1812. He died on 2 March 1826.

Rae, William – William Rae Jr. married in 1799 to Emelia Collier, daughter of Emelia Cooper and John Collier Jr., making Emelia Collier Rae the granddaughter of George and Mary Ellis Cooper and the niece of Frederick Cooper. His father, William Rae Sr. died in 1796, leaving all of his property to his two sons, John and William Rae Jr.

Rogers, Edwin – He married in 1817 to Lucy Collier, daughter of Emelia Cooper and John Collier Jr., making Lucy Collier Rogers the granddaughter of George and Mary Ellis Cooper and the niece of Frederick Cooper.

Sebrell, Charles – He was a man of African descent born about 1770 to an enslaved woman, probably one of Nathaniel Sebrell's enslaved women, either Lina or Lydia. Nathaniel Sebrell paid taxes on

Charles each year between 1782 and 1795. The 1796 and 1797 tax records did not record the slaves' names, but in 1798, 1799, and 1800, Nathaniel did not pay taxes on Charles. In 1801 and 1802, Thomas Peter paid taxes on twenty slaves, including one named "*Charles*," who is presumably Charles Sebrell. In 1803 and 1804, neither Thomas Peter nor Nathaniel Sebrell paid taxes on Charles. This suggests Charles may have been a skilled worker. Thomas Peter freed Charles Sebrell on 25 February 1806, describing him as "*a dark Mullatto, aged about thirty six years, five feet eight inches high.*" Peter said that he had purchased Charles from "*Mr. Nathaniel Sebrell as pr. Bill of sale of this date.*" On 12 March 1806, a Surry County official described Charles as

...a Mulatto man...five feet five inches and three fourths of an inch high...stout and well made, short hair for a mulatto has lost two of his fore teeth (one upper and one under), has a scar a little above the outward corner of his left eye.

Charles paid personal taxes most years through 1827. He is probably the free person enumerated in Nathaniel Sebrell's 1810 household in Surry County. He died outside Water Spratley's tavern in Cabin Point on 7 September 1830.

Seward, William Caufield – In 1777, he married Mary Ann Faulcon, daughter of Nicholas Faulcon Sr. and sister-in-law to Nathaniel Sebrell. A wealthy plantation owner, William Caufield Seward served as an officer in the Surry County Militia during the Revolutionary War. Possibly as a result of his military service, his health became questionable in 1780, prompting him to make a will. He died in 1782, leaving son by his first marriage, Caufield Seward, and daughter, Martha, the only descendant of Mary Ann Faulcon Seward.

Spratley – Numerous Spratleys lived in Surry County during the eighteenth and nineteenth centuries. The white Spratleys all descended from John Spratley III (1720/1725–1758) and his wife, Mary Cocke (1725/1730–1773), while the free blacks carrying the Spratley surname were primarily descended from slaves freed by John and Mary's son, Benjamin, in 1783. John and Mary Spratley had five known sons. Walter Spratley died in 1777 while serving in the Virginia Militia during the Revolutionary War, but the others, William, John, Benjamin, and Thomas, all spent their lives farming in Surry County:

Capt. William Spratley – He served as guardian to his younger brothers, Benjamin and Thomas, until they reached the age of twenty-one. The Surry County Court appoint him as vestryman for Southwark Parish in 1775, and in November 1780, the Virginia Governor appointed him as Sheriff of Surry County. In 1783, they commissioned him as a captain in the Surry County Militia. William Spratley married in 1773 to Ann Faulcon, daughter of Nicholas Faulcon Sr. and sister-in-law to Nathaniel Sebrell. In December 1791, William Spratley married Mary White,

indicating that Ann Faulcon Spratley died prior to 1791. William Spratley died about 1795–1796, for personal property taxes were paid on his estate in 1796. Children of William Spratley Sr. and Ann Faulcon:

William Spratley Jr. (c1775–c1836) – He was listed in his father’s household in 1792–1794.

John Spratley (c1785–1847) – After the death of his father about 1796, he and his younger brother chose their uncle, Thomas Spratley, as their guardian.

Walter Spratley Jr. (c1786–1824) – He was the younger man by this name in Surry County, and to distinguish him from his first cousin, he typically used the suffix “Jr.” in Surry County legal records. He lived in Surry County until about 1814, when he moved to Sussex County. He died there in 1824.

John Spratley – served as Under Sheriff of Surry County beginning in November 1780 under his brother, Sheriff William Spratley. He married Ann and died about 1793. It is not known if they had children.

Benjamin Spratley & Susanna Sebrell – married before 1780 to Susanna, daughter of Nathaniel Sebrell Sr. and Elizabeth Faulcon. Benjamin owned eleven slaves in 1782, but in 1783, stating that he believed in freedom for all people, he emancipated them. Perhaps suffering from poor health as a young man, Benjamin wrote his will in January 1789, but he lived until December 1791 or January 1792. Susanna Sebrell Spratley only survived him by a year or two, dying about 1794. Only one daughter and two sons of Benjamin Spratley and Susanna Sebrell survived to adulthood; all of them are grandchildren of Nathaniel Sebrell Sr.:

Mary Spratley [Polly] (c1780–Aft. 1839) – remained single through 1839. She appears only on one tax record.

Walter Spratley Sr. (c1782–1833) – he became a wealthy plantation owner, tavernkeeper, and merchant at Cabin Point.

Nathaniel Spratley (c1791–1846) – he first appears by name on the 1813 personal property tax list, but he is probably the other white male listed in the household of his brother,

Walter, in earlier years. Nathaniel was born after January 1789, as his father's will did not mention him by name.

Thomas Spratley – the youngest child of his parents, he was born about 1758 and married Ann Holdsworth in 1783. He served as Surry County Tax Commissioner in the 1790s and died young about 1797. Their known sons:

Peter Thomas Spratley (c1790–1853) – he became a wealthy plantation owner, justice of the peace, and fulfilled various other civic duties during his lifetime.

William Hamlin Spratley (1790/1797–1830) –

Lewis Meredith Spratley (1790/1797–1820) –

Velvin, John – He married in 1800 to Permelia Cooper, daughter of Constable John Cooper, brother of George Cooper. This made Velvin the husband of the first cousin of Jane Cooper Stiles, Frederick Cooper, and Emelia Cooper Collier. Velvin does not appear to be a native of Surry County but presumably moved there in 1800 to marry Permelia. He later became a local constable and served as captain of a company of Surry County Militia during the War of 1812.

Until 1797, Surry County officials issued tax assessments in the standard American version of British currency from the latter colonial period, in pounds (£), shillings (s), and pence (d). Twenty shillings equaled one pound, while twelve pennies equaled one shilling. The abbreviation of “d” used for pence came from “*denarius*,” the Latin term for this coin. Beginning in 1798, Virginia law required county officials to assess taxes in dollars and cents.

The other, known as the "*Cabin Point District*," consisted of the remainder of the county, the area away from the river and south to the Blackwater Swamp.

The elder man, shown here as *"Walter Spratley Gent,"* was the son of Susanna Sebrell and Benjamin Spratley. The younger man, shown here as *"Walter Spratley jr,"* was the son of Capt. William Spratley Sr. and younger brother of William and John Spratley shown here.
3. Peter T. Spratley was another first cousin of the other Spratleys, the eldest surviving son of Thomas Spratley, who had died about 1797 and Ann Holdsworth Spratley, who had died in 1807.
4. The other white male above sixteen years on which Walter Spratley Sr. paid a white poll was probably his younger brother, Nathaniel Spratley. Both of them were grandsons of Nathaniel Sebrell Sr.
